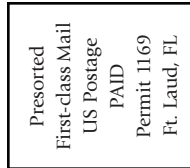

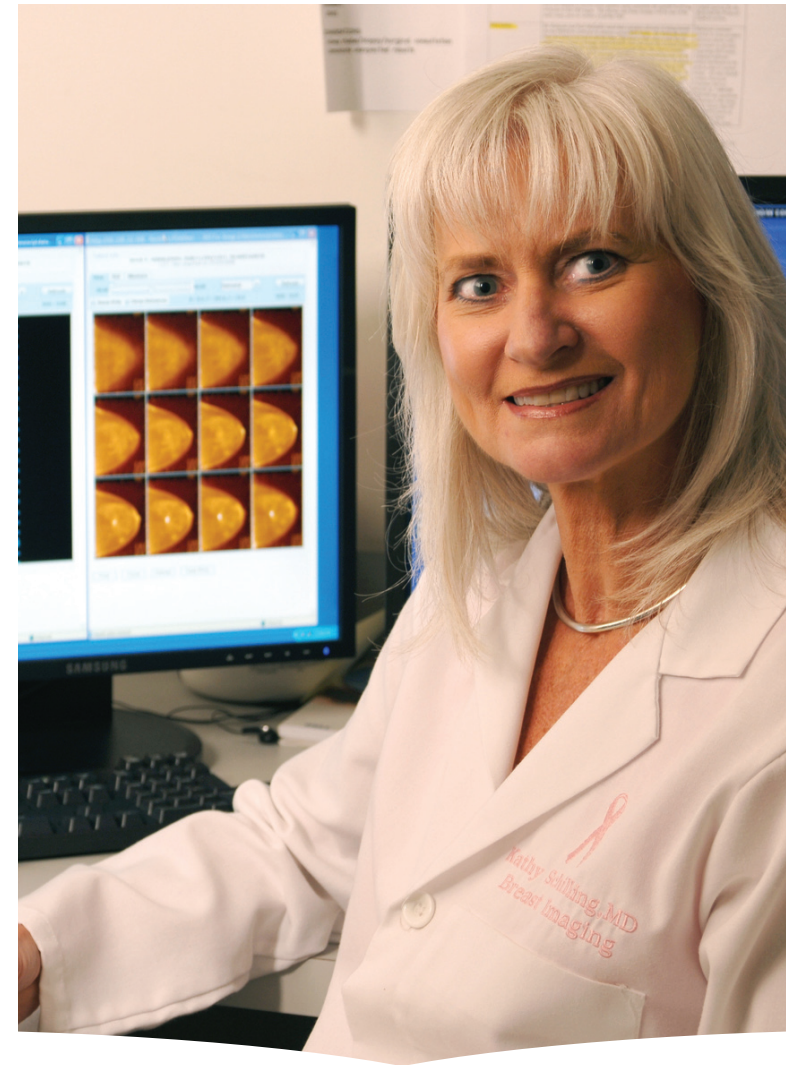

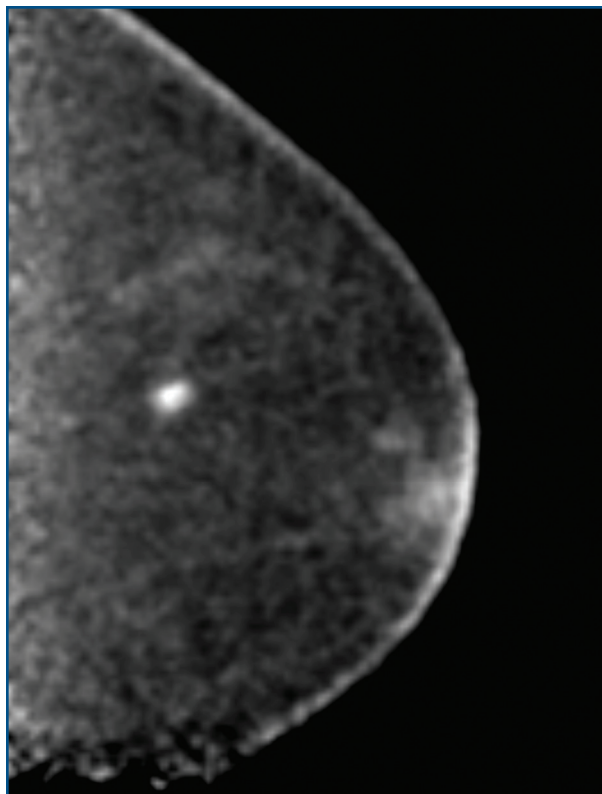

Positron Emission Mammography (PEM) is the newest molecular imaging technology that can impact a woman's chance of survival from breast cancer.

The Center for Breast Care at Boca Raton Community Hospital is offering a Clinical Visiting Fellowship in PEM.

It is a program developed and designed for the physicians dedicated to breast imaging who would like to acquire more experience in the interpretation of PEM.



### **Course Description**

Presented by the Physicians for Women's Health at the Center for Breast Care at the Women's Center, this is a unique 12-hour course that is designed to provide a comprehensive review of more than 50 PEM exams. The participant will have the opportunity to review teaching file PEM cases with mammographic, sonographic, MRI and pathologic correlation. Additionally, the physician will have the opportunity to read active cases with the faculty on site.

- Differentiate benign from malignant breast lesions
- Use the BI-RADS nomenclature for PEM
- Implement a comprehensive breast program which includes PEM
